1. Entry Fee \$30.00 for Driver & Car. Pit crew will pay same as grandstand fee.
2. Pay-off full-size cars 1st - \$1,100 2nd - \$600 3rd - \$400 and trophies
Compact cars 1st - \$1,100 2nd - \$600 3rd - \$400 and trophies
Builders class (full size cars only) 1st - \$1,300 2nd - \$900 3rd-\$600 and trophies
Full-size trucks 1st - \$1,800 2nd - \$900 3rd - \$600 and trophies
3. There will be two classes of cars and one class of trucks – full-size and compact and builders class (in full-size cars) with pay off in each class

JUDGES' DECISIONS ARE FINAL

We will be accepting only the first 60 entries. ALL PARTICIPATING CARS SHALL PASS INSPECTION BY THE JUDGES. JUDGES' DECISIONS ARE FINAL!! Inspection will be done between 4:00 and 6:30 p.m. on Sunday of the Barron County Fair. Cars may enter fairgrounds starting at 3:00 p.m.

1. Every driver shall have attained his 18th birthday, 16 to 18 year olds must have parents sign an affidavit giving permission to participate.
2. Driver's meeting at 6:30 p.m.
3. All cars must be equipped with satisfactory seat belts. Drivers must wear an approved helmet. Seat belts and helmets will be worn at all times when on the track. Failure to do so will mean disqualification. Shoulder harness are recommended. All drivers must have eye protection, i.e., safety glasses, helmet shield.
4. Every racetrack has many uses. Therefore, ALL WINDOWS, TAILLIGHTS, HEADLIGHTS, CHROME, AND MIRRORS MUST BE REMOVED BEFORE COMING TO THE FAIRGROUNDS. Glass falling from the car will result in disqualification. No studded tires allowed.
5. All insulation under the hood shall be removed.
6. All sharp protruding metal shall be removed including trailer hitches.
7. All gas tanks must be removed from original position and securely fastened in rear seating area. Approved gas tanks only, no more than 5 gallons of gas on board. NO CANS!
8. No cars shall be altered to raise the height of the stock position.
9. All doors must be securely fastened with chain or cable, welding driver's door only, no larger than 3/8 rod may be used in door crack. Hoods must have 18-inch square hole in case of fire. NO WELDING HOOD OR TRUNK LIDS. Threaded rod may also be used to secure the hood and the trunk.
10. No convertibles, hearses, ambulances, panel trucks, AMC pacers or Imperials allowed.
11. There shall be no numbers on any part of the car. Judges will number cars. Driver's door must be painted white.
12. Radiators must be in stock position. No extra water in car and no starting fluid. Must have working fan.

13. Battery can be moved to the front if it is covered and securely fastened.
14. ABSOLUTELY NO ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES IN THE PIT AREA OR ON THE TRACK.
15. No welded or altered suspension. Stock Suspension Only. No additional welding to strengthen body or suspension. No spring jacks, blocked shocks or reversed shackles are permitted.
16. No snow tires allowed on rear or drivers wheels.
17. Absolutely no reinforcement of any part of the vehicle or materials in trunks will be allowed.
18. No welding station wagon tailgates. Tailgates may be secured with 2 lengths of chain or wire strap not to exceed 30" in length.
19. New model cars with impact bumpers on the front may be welded to the piston not the bracket.
20. No added transmission cooling systems will be permitted. Must be stock.
21. There must be a visual hole to the trunk of a 6" square through the trunk cover or back seat.
22. Engine must be of the same manufacturer as the body of the car. Motor mounts must be factory stock, chaining will be permitted, absolutely no welding permitted. Maximum 12" stacks will be permitted above engines above hood.
23. All cars must have brakes before beginning of the heat.
24. Chains or bars in front of driver from roof to hood is recommended. Any bars added for driver's protection are ok.
25. Slant bar behind the seat is allowed for driver safety.
26. Any type of collision is legal except disregarding another driver's safety. Holding will not be allowed.
27. Any driver purposely ramming an already disqualified car will also be disqualified.
28. All events have boundaries that you will be advised about. If you don't stay within them except as directed by an official, you will be disqualified.
29. Trucks
 - (A) Will be 2-wheel drive only (if 4-wheel drives are used, front drive shaft must be removed).
 - (B) Run what you bring as long as you do not get voted out by other drivers at the drivers meeting and it looks stock from the outside.

BUILDERS CLASS (Full-size cars only)

The car must look stock from the outside other than the driver's side door. (Do what you have to do to protect yourself).
