Open to members Grade 3 or 1st year member Grade 4. (Cloverbuds must enter class numbers from Division B, 1-32 rather than Exploring class numbers.)

A member may enter any of the following class numbers. *Posters must be no smaller than 11"x14" and no larger than 22"x22" in size. White tagboard or posterboard to be used for mounting posters.*

## DIVISION A. EXPLORING

### CLASS NUMBER

1. Rock Creatures
2. Paper bag puppet
3. A puppet other than a paper bag
4. Terrarium
5. A collection of 10 wildflowers or 10 tree leaves identified with common names, pressed, mounted and exhibited in a scrapbook.
6. 10 mounted insects, identified with common names, mounted on styrofoam. Styrofoam may be placed in box or other display case.
7. A simple bird feeder, not necessarily wood joints
8. Homemade musical instrument
9. A simple craft article, not from a kit
10. Any article made from a kit
11. A drawing or sketch in pencil mounted on 22"x14" white tagboard or posterboard.
12. A simple wall hanging for your room
13. Self drawn portrait of any subject
14. A self drawn family portrait
15. Junk Food Poster (emphasis on what is junk food)
16. Hazard hunt poster (emphasis on what are hazards)
17. Map of my neighborhood poster

18. A simple woodworking item
19. Writing exhibit (ORIGINAL poems, stories, or interviews)
20. An exhibit related to what was done or learned in the exploring 4-H project
21. A simple plant
22. Cookies, (3), unfrosted on paper plate and enclosed in plastic bag.
23. Baked dessert item, no mix, unfrosted, no nuts, (3), on paper plate and enclosed in plastic bag.
24. Baked dessert item, mix, unfrosted, no nuts, (3) on paper plate and enclosed in plastic bag.
25. 4 photographs you have taken, black & white or colored, mounted on white tagboard or posterboard 11"x14".
26. Shadowing animal project. Photo diary of activities in preparing animal for fair, including project meetings attended, daily care, training and specialty care, include why animal was chosen, what was learned and if you would take project in future.
27. 4 photographs of interesting items found in nature, named.
28. 4 photographs showing beauty in nature or interesting architecture. Tell why they are beautiful or interesting. Use white tagboard or posterboard 22"x14".
29. Plant grown from seed/bulb.
30. Simple sewing project/needlepoint/quilting. (display with/pattern)
31. Exhibit made at 4-H Adventure Days.
32. Exhibit made from a kit at 4-H Adventure Days.

### **EXPLANATION**

Any exhibit that would be the result of a kit assembly, must be entered in class 10, with the exception of one made from a kit at 4-H Adventure Days.

## DIVISION B. CLOVERBUDS

Open to members who are enrolled in the Cloverbud Program, Grades Kindergarten thru 2nd grade. Cloverbuds.

*Posters must be no smaller than 11"x14" and no larger than 22"x22" in size. White tagboard or posterboard to be used for posters.*

### **CLASS NUMBER**

1. Collection of 5 tree leaves or 5 wildflowers, identified, with common names, pressed and mounted in scrapbook.

2. Scrapbook of five birds you have seen and identified (drawing, photographs, tracings.)
3. Display of five mounted insects. identified with common names and displayed on styrofoam.
4. Tell with words, pictures or photos on a poster about your favorite animal, bird or pet (size, color, where it lives, eats, how you care for it, etc) Poster should be 22" x 14"
5. Poster - life cycle of an insect.
6. Poster - drawing of the parts of a flower blossom - identify the flower and its parts.
7. Poster 22"x14" - drawing of life cycle of plant or tree.
8. Home safety poster
9. Two mounted photographs showing the beauty in nature. Tell why they are beautiful. Poster 22" x 14"
10. Four photographs you have taken, black and white or colored, mounted with description, any subject..
11. A simple art or craft article you have made (no kits or pre-cut materials)
12. A simple art or craft article you have made from a kit
13. Simple sewing article you have made.
14. A woodworking article you have made
15. Any article of creative design made from wood.
16. Puzzle made from wood
17. One plate of vegetables you have grown, (plate of 4 and in a plastic bag).  
Example: 4 carrots or 4 tomatoes or 4 beets, etc.
18. House plant grown from a cutting (foliage)
19. A house plant you have grown from a cutting (flowering)
20. Plant you have grown from a bulb
21. Plant you have grown from a seed (grapefruit, lemon, etc.)
22. Terrarium you have made (must have cover)
23. (3) cookies. not using a mix, unfrosted, no nuts. Must be on a paper plate, in plastic bag, & tied.
24. Baked dessert item (3), mix, unfrosted, no nuts. Must be on a paper plate, in a plastic bag, and tied.
25. Baked dessert item (3), no mix, unfrosted, no nuts. Must be on a paper plate, in a plastic bag and tied.
26. Electro-magnet
27. 4 photos of interesting articles you have found in nature, securely displayed.
28. Any other item made in the cloverbud project
29. Any exhibit made at 4-H Adventure Days.
30. Any exhibit made from a kit at 4-H Adventure Days.
31. Cloverbud (Individual) Activity Book.
