All entries will be conference judged on Tuesday of Fair Week from 1-6 pm in the Youth Expo Building.

1. All photographs must be taken by the exhibitor during this 4-H year.
2. Entries will be judged with respect to technical quality composition, impact, and story telling ability.
3. Exhibitors may enter a maximum of five entries.
4. Pictures must not have individual captions.
5. Photographs must be securely mounted with rubber cement or durable adhesive. Corner mounts will not be allowed.
6. Matting and/or framing will not be allowed. No borders, outlining, or decorating of photo, tagboard or posterboard allowed.
7. All photographs must be the standard size of your camera except where size is indicated (3 1/2" x 5" or 4" x 6" is allowed). No panoramic allowed.
8. All exhibits must be mounted on **WHITE, 14"x14" TAGBOARD OR POSTERBOARD.**
9. Prints larger than 8"x10" will not be allowed in any class.
10. Fasten entry tags on the upper right hand corner of the exhibit.
11. Digital camera entries only in digital class.
12. In digital entries, no computer-altered pictures are allowed. Only cropping is acceptable.
13. Recommended that electronic photo dating on camera is turned off when taking pictures

20. One 8"x10" or 5"x7" of scenery (**color**).
21. Your favorite picture 5"x7" or 8"x10" (**color**).
22. Your favorite picture 5"x7" or 8"x10" (**black and white**).
