### DIVISION A: BEGINNERS—THIS IS WHERE I LIVE—(Grades 3-5)

Open to members enrolled in the project, "This is Where I Live" and other groups doing equivalent work.

***\*Items must include description of room or area where article could be used & swatches or pictures of wallpaper, fabric, carpeting, etc, used in the room. This should be securely attached to entry.***

#### **CLASS NUMBER**

1. Decorative pillow
2. Decorative curtains
3. Decorative spread
4. Appliqued article (Example: pillow, mat, appliance cover)
5. Place mat with napkins for dining table to be exhibited with glass and plate
6. Wall hanging – from a kit (must be prepared for hanging)
7. Wall plaque original design, with hook or wire

8. Centerpiece for family dining table, with silk or dried flowers, no more than 10-12" high.
9. \*Poster or display with photos showing how you redecorated a room or home design showing how it could be remodeled and why. Include description.
