**Dog Show, Wednesday of Fair Week
following
the Junior Class Dog Show at
the Fairgrounds starting at 9 am**

1. All entries limited to Barron County residents. All exhibitors and dogs participate at their own risk.
2. All dogs exhibited must have the following vaccinations. DHLPP, Parvo-Virus and Rabies and must be current during the training period. Corona and Kennel Cough (bordatella) are recommended. A negative fecal check is also recommended. Send in with fair registration.
3. A LICENSED VETERINARIAN must vaccinate all dogs. Certificates of vaccination will be required prior to dog being unloaded at the fair.
4. Handler may have no more than two obedience dogs, but only one dog per obedience division.
5. Only the handler may approach the dog show superintendent or judge with objections to judging and/or scoring.
6. Obedience dogs in season allowed to show in special area. Notify ring stewards prior to unloading dog at the fair.
7. No aggressive dogs will be permitted.
